

ASIS International Providence, Rhode Island Chapter Scholarship

Public Safety Education Scholarship Award Guidelines

Purpose

This scholarship was established by the members of the ASIS International Providence Chapter in order to promote professionalism and education with the security field, and to provide educational assistance to college students pursuing an undergraduate degree in the Criminal Justice, Law Enforcement, Security Management, or other Security related fields.

Guidelines for Awarding the Scholarships:

The award process will be competitive. The selection committee will choose the worthy candidates to receive the awards based on the criteria established. The selection of the scholarship recipients will be based on merit, without regard to race, religion, sex or other demographic factors.

Eligibility

Applicant must be pursuing a Degree Program in a Criminal Justice, Security Management or related field in an Accredited Institution.

Applicant must be enrolled in a formal degree program.

Applicant must provide all documents requested and complete the application form

Applicant must submit an essay of not less than 500 words, and not more than 1000 words explaining his or her career and educational objectives, and why he/she warrants the award of the scholarship.

Applicant should want to advance his/her career in the Criminal Justice or Security Management fields.

Criteria

The criteria of this scholarship is to identify appropriate applicants who have demonstrated professionalism and exemplary performance within their chosen degree program in the required field(s), have shown the personal traits of good character, and are in the process of enhancing their skills through formal education. Applicants who receive this scholarship are not guaranteed awards for future years.

Application Packet

The application form should be completely filled out. The Application Packet should include the following items:

- Personal information form
- 500 to 1000 word essay describing students career and educational objectives, and why he/she warrants to award of the scholarship.
- Personal recommendation Form (Submit up to 3 personal recommendations)
- Most recent school transcript

Responsibilities of the Recipient

The recipient understands that by accepting this scholarship he/she may be asked to provide an educational progress report to Chapter Officers if requested.

Selection Process

All applications should be received by August 15th of each year. The selection committee will review all applications through the end of August.

Award Announcement

Selection Committee: Will be composed of volunteer chapter officers and members of the ASIS International Providence Chapter.
